




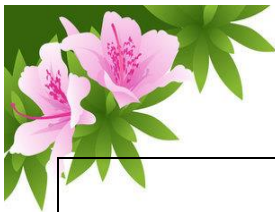
**SILVER HORIZON TO OKINAWA JAPAN**  
**11 - 16 MAR 2025**

**6 DAYS/5 NIGHTS IKIGAI TIME IN OKINAWA**

*Situated at the southwestern most tip of the Japanese archipelago, Okinawa, the island prefecture, consists of 160 islands, including 48 that are inhabited. The history of Okinawa stretches back thousands of years, to prehistoric times. But its peak developed from the trading era of Ryukyu Kingdom that lasted for more than 400 years, and was characterized by booming trade with Japan, China, and other Asian countries like the Philippines and Thailand. This confluence of cultures in one place gave birth to unique traditions that continue to define Okinawa’s island culture. Spring is in the air in Okinawa in March and the pleasant weather is ideal for outdoor activities with its mild temperatures. It is also a good season to explore Okinawa’s rich ceramic traditions by visiting a pottery market. Okinawa is one of the blue zones regions and has some of the highest life expectancy rates in the world. So, what are they eating? Residents live with intention, have life-long friends, and eat lots of vegetables. On this trip, learn more about practice of “Hara Hachi bu” and concept of “Ikigai”.*

01 / 11 Mar Tue <b>Singapore/Naha</b>  <b>3K791 SINOKA</b> <b>Dep 0200hrs</b> <b>Arr 0810hrs</b>	Depart by <b>3K791</b> early this morning for Okinawa. Upon arrival, clear immigrations and be welcomed by our English-speaking guide at the airport. Enjoy a local breakfast before we visit to a local fish market. The islands of Okinawa are surrounded by warm, clear waters, teeming with fish. The tuna catch in Okinawa is among the largest in Japan, and fresh tuna is easy to come by. At the <b>Tomari Iyumachi</b> (Fish Market) in Naha, you find specialized tuna vendors from the Okinawa Fishing Cooperative. About 70% of the catch sold here is tuna, so Tomari Iyumachi is one of the best places to try fresh tuna. Following lunch at local restaurant, we then conduct a hotel check-in where we will stay for 5 nights located in the international area of <b>Kokusai Street</b> and rest or perhaps explore the surrounding area for own orientation. 02 / 12 Mar Wed <b>Southern Okinawa</b>	Breakfast at the hotel before we discover the southern part of Okinawa We start with <b>Okinawa World Culture Kingdom</b> that recreates an Okinawan settlement from the days of the Ryūkyū Kingdom. It introduces visitors to the history, culture, and nature of the islands. Within the Okinawa World is the <b>Gyokusendo Cave</b> , a large, 5-kilometer-long cave system, considered to be the most beautiful in East Asia, where we walk 890 metres to explore more than one million stalactites and stalagmites which have formed over the centuries. Then be entertained at the <b>Okinawa Eisa Drum Dance Show</b> , a performance combining dancing and drumming, normally staged on the last day of the Obon festival in summer to see off visiting ancestral spirits. Enjoy Lunch at local restaurant before we continue our tour to the **Okinawa Peace Memorial Park**, that advocates world peace and mourns the lives lost on all sides of the Battle of Okinawa. Visit the onsite Okinawa Peace Hall to see a large statue of Buddha and an impactful series of artwork depicting war and peace. We end our day finding out about **Umibudo** (sea grapes), an Okinawan specialty. Not only can you see and touch the sea grapes during the farm tour, your **Sea Grape Picking Experience** allows you to harvest to your heart's content follows with a tasting of raw sea grape soft serve and fresh sea grapes harvested in the morning. We return to Naha for dinner at local restaurant



03 / 13 Mar Thu  
**Northern Okinawa**

Breakfast at hotel. Today we discover the sights of northern Okinawa commencing with a visit to **Chura-umi Aquarium** boasting a huge acrylic viewing window that allows you to view impressive manta rays, tiger sharks, and whale sharks from up close. Following lunch, we visit the ruins of **Nakijin Castle**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and was one of the largest gusuku castles in Okinawa. Connecting to Yagaji Island by a remote island bridge spanning 1,960 metres, we visit **Kouri Island** dubbed "**Love Island**", an iconic heart-shaped rock formation, and a legend about an Okinawan Adam and Eve. From the **Kouri Ocean Tower** (82 m), you enjoy the best views on the island: gazing out across the ocean, and over Kouri Bridge back toward the main island. We then return to Naha for dinner at a local restaurant.

**Central Naha**

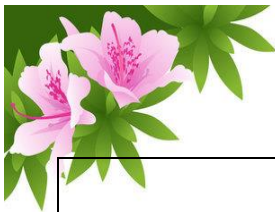
Breakfast at hotel. Today we explore the sights nearer to Naha. We ventured out to the neighboring islands of Ikei, Henza & Miyagi, all accessible by bridge in search of the famous Okinawian sea salt factory, **Nuchi Masu**. Nuchi Masu salt has many health benefits, including 200 times the magnesium and 10 times the potassium of other salts. A short walk (2 min) from the entrance of Nuchi Masu Sea Salt Factory brings you to Happy Cliff for an amazing view of the ocean.

Following lunch, we leave for the **Shikinaen Garden**, located on a small hill to the south of Shuri Castle. Constructed in 1799 as a villa for the royal family of the Ryukyu Kingdom, it is a World Heritage Site. The garden is a strolling garden, and you may find delicate, pink apricot and cherry trees that bloom in spring. Next (time permitting), we visit

	<p><b>Shurijo Castle</b>, which prospered as the Ryukyu Kingdom's center of politics, diplomacy and culture from 1429 to 1879 and is now inscribed on UNESCO's World Heritage List. Just a short walk from Shurijo Castle is <b>Tama Udun Mausoleum</b>, the final resting place of the royal family of the second Sho Dynasty of the Ryukyu Kingdom built in 1501. Notice how it is modeled after Shurijo Castle. Moving on, we then immerse ourselves in the <b>art of coral dyeing</b>, an Okinawan traditional craft, at Shuri Ryuzen. With simple instructions using material provided, you get to take home your very own coral dyeing experience works (30-40 mins). We then adjourn to Naha for dinner at local restaurant.</p>	
<p>05 / 15 Mar Sat  <b>Home Visit</b></p>	<p><i>The islands of Okinawa are one of the world's "Blue Zones," areas where a population has a life expectancy much higher than the global average. So what is the secret? Maybe it is in the food. Okinawan's have a word, <b>nuchigusui</b>, which they use to describe their cuisine. It literally means "medicine of life," and indicates how, for the people of Okinawa, food is more than just sustenance; it is something that nourishes both body and mind.</i> Following breakfast at hotel, we divide our group into 4-5 persons per sub-group as we journey to <b>meet up with local hosts</b> at their home for activities. Experience spending time with an ordinary family in Okinawa and experience the farming lifestyle of Okinawan people for a morning. At the same time, maybe learn Japanese and Okinawan cultures while enjoying lunch with the local family. Bid farewell to your hosts and return to our meet-up place. This afternoon, we explore <b>Kokusai Street, Makishi Market, Heiwa Street</b> with endless tunnels of shops with locals and tourists alike, surrounded by fresh fruits and vegetables, cafés, sweets, desserts and souvenir shops. Back to our hotel to rest before dinner at a local restaurant.</p>	<p>BLD</p>

Every tour participant (member or otherwise of SHTC) is deemed to have read and understood the general booking terms and conditions set by ISE Travel (The Company) and agrees to abide by them during the time of acceptance of your booking.

**DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT**

To confirm your booking, a non-refundable deposit (as specified by SHTC) is payable at the time of booking and the balance sum (total package price less deposit) must be made to the Company:

Up to 100% of package price not less than 45 days before departure date.

In the event of default in effecting payment of the balance sum by the said time period, the booking may be cancelled by the Company at its sole discretion and you shall waive all rights of recourse against the Company. For bookings made less than 45 days before departure date, full payment shall be made upon booking.

**TRAVEL DOCUMENTS - VISA & IMMIGRATION CLEARANCE**

It is your responsibility (and those travelling with you) to ensure that valid travel documents and requisite visa approvals have been obtained before departure. Where there is a requirement for production of vaccination and health certificates, you will be advised to make the necessary preparations well in advance. The Company accepts no responsibility for any delay or complications due to non-compliance or non-fulfillment of immigration, health or other governmental requirements on your part. The Company will assist in your application wherever possible and necessary. However it does not guarantee approval of visa application or entry into the country. In instances where the Company is assisting you to make the necessary entry applications, you expressly agree that you shall not hold the Company responsible if such application is rejected for whatever reason.

**TRAVEL INSURANCE**

The Company strongly urges every group member to enroll with a required medical insurance plan covering hospitalization, Pre Existing Illnesses and Emergency Medical Evacuation through an approved insurance company. This coverage is valid only for traveling to the same geographic destination for the same number of days by the same mode of transportation. If more insurance coverage is required (for yourself as well as those travelling with you) to cover over and above the approved insurance, ISE Travel would be happy to recommend an appropriate policy.







## **CANCELLATION BY COMPANY & REFUND POLICY**

The Company reserves to itself the sole right to cancel any tour due to insufficient number of participants or due to factors beyond the reasonable control of the Company such as but not limited to natural disasters, pandemic variants, labour strikes, war, civil unrest and disorders, etc. In the unlikely event of cancellation of tour, the Company shall endeavour to notify you soonest possible if cancellation should be necessary due to factors beyond the reasonable control of the Company. The Company shall endeavour to recommend or provide alternatives for your consideration but should you decide not to accept the alternatives, you shall be entitled to a refund of all monies paid by you to the Company after deducting expenses incurred (if any) for visa and other applications made on your behalf. Neither party shall have any claim against the other thereafter.

## **CANCELLATION BY CUSTOMER**

You may cancel your booking at any time provided notice of cancellation is given in writing. As the Company would have made arrangements in reliance on your prior booking, the following cancellation charges must be borne by you:

For cancellation received at least 45 days before departure ... 50%\*

For cancellation received between 30 & 44 days before departure ... 100%\*

\* or deposit whichever is higher

*However in the event that arrangements were confirmed with a supplier with a different cancellation/deposit terms (especially low cost carriers) from the above stated, we will advise you accordingly prior to making reservations. In this case, the cancellation policies of the above plus the supplier involved will apply.*

## **REFUND OF UNUSED SERVICES**

Should you decide not (or unable) to utilize the accommodation, meals, sightseeing tours, transport or other services included in the package fares during the course of the tour, no refund or exchange shall be allowed.

## **AIRPORT CHARGES, SURCHARGES & TAXES**

Unless expressly included in the negotiations and confirmed in the quotation acceptance, all airport charges, surcharges and taxes imposed by airport, custom or other authorities are usually included in our package price. However should there be a sudden announcement of increase in related charges, taxes and surcharges after the quotation has been accepted, these shall be at your responsibility.

**CHANGES, TRANSFERS & DEVIATIONS**

If the proposed change or deviation results in a cancellation of the booking or part thereof, the cancellation charges must be borne by you.

**CHANGES INITIATED BY THE COMPANY**

The Company makes every effort possible to avoid changes in itinerary but should changes be necessitated by factors beyond the reasonable control of the Company including (but not limited to) war, civil disorder, changes in airline schedules, weather or local conditions, the Company shall be entitled to do so subject to notice being given as soon as possible and the Company shall endeavour to substitute a suitable arrangement of similar standard and you shall have no entitlement to compensation of any form.

**CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE**

In all cases where a component of the tour includes travel on scheduled flights in aircrafts or scheduled routes in all other modes of travel, your attention is expressly drawn to the fact that the Company has no direct control over changes in schedules or the manner in which the services are provided and hence you agree that you will not hold the Company responsible for the same.

**COMPANY ACTING AS AGENT**

In all cases where the Company is acting as an agent for a principal such as in cases of flight, vehicle-hire or hotel reservations, the Company will not accept any responsibility for any default, delay or deficiency on the part of the principal. In such events, you expressly agree to seek recourse against the principal directly and to the extent as may be allowed by law, you expressly waive all rights against the Company.

**RESPONSIBILITY**

In respect of services provided, the Company only accepts responsibility for such services over which it has full and direct control. The Company does not accept liability or responsibility for any acts, omissions or defaults of other service providers unless the same could have been reasonably avoided by the Company or unless the same is caused directly by the negligence of the Company, its servants or agents.

## **THIRD PARTY RIGHTS**

For the purposes of the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act and notwithstanding any other provisions set forth in this document, this Agreement is not intended to, and does not, give any person who is not a party to it any right to enforce any of its provisions.

## **CLAIMS & DISPUTE RESOLUTION**

Should you have any complaint, it is desirable that the same be notified to the Company immediately so that action may be taken to resolve the same expeditiously. Your complaint should preferably be in writing and forwarded to the Company not later than 14 days after completion of your trip.
