## 6 DAYS/5 NIGHTS SIEM REAP/BATTAMBANG (Dep 09 Jan 2023)

DAY 1 (09 Jan Mon): Singapore/Siem Reap	
Depart today for Siem Reap on Singapore Airlines. On arrival, meet and greet by our local English speaking guide for your transfer to your hotel follows by a Khmer lunch. This afternoon, enjoy the antics of the <b>Hero Rats</b> and experience the realities of humanitarian demining and how rats are trained to save lives.  After checking in our hotel, cruise around the city for an orientation tour including sights of the <b>French Quarter, Royal Palace, Siem Reap River</b> and <b>Independence Garden</b> before we enjoy a buffet dinner which features traditional Khmer cuisine together with a taste of Japanese, Vietnamese, Chinese, European and western dishes accompanied by traditional	Meal on Board LD
Apsara dances. Time permits, we explore the Angkor Night Market before turning in.

DAY 2 (10 Jan Tue): Siem Reap Angkor Sunrise & Exploration  Early this morning, wake up and journey into the darkness of Siem Reap to witness the lovely sunrise over the ancient Angkor Wat (optional). Back to hotel to freshen up and breakfast.	BLD
A full day of sights awaits exploring the main temples of Angkor starting with the entrance through the gateway of <b>Angkor Thom</b> city built in the 13 <sup>th</sup> century by King Jayavarman VII. Marvel at the intricate carvings of daily local and court life of ancient Khmers at the <b>Bayon</b> which features giant smiling faces.	
Then through the elephant parade ground, we exit Angkor Thom to the forested grounds of <b>Ta Phrom</b> – once a hospital of ancient Angkor which is now made famous by the movie "Tomb Raider". Here you encounter giant trees reclaiming man made structure on a land once belonged to Mother Nature. Enjoy a local Khmer lunch at a popular restaurant this afternoon before we return to hotel to freshen up.	
We continue our final visit to the World Heritage <b>Angkor Wat</b> – until today, the world's largest religious building built in the mid 12 <sup>th</sup> century by King Suryavarman II. We then proceed for our dinner at a local Khmer restaurant.

Day 3 (11 Jan Wed): Siem Reap/Battambang (3 hrs)	
Breakfast at hotel. Check out and depart by VIP coach for <b>Battambang</b> , a 11 <sup>th</sup> century city and the centre of rice producing province being the food basket of Cambodia. Dotted with	BLD





lovely colonial French architecture, Battambang offers the visitor a nolstalgic charm of colonial French lifestyle. Arriving at Battambang, we go on an orientation tour of the city, stopping by the **Ta Dumbong Kro Aung Statue** (Black man Statue) before enjoying a local lunch and exploring the local market.

We continue our tour with a enchanting sight of the famous bat spectacle at sunset at **Phnom Sampeau** before we relax at dinner by the Sangkae riverside.

## DAY 4 (12 Jan Thu): Battambang

Breakfast at hotel. This morning, we meet our cooking instructor, take a relaxing visit to the **Central Market**, taste unique fruits and pick up your own ingredients. With ingredients in hand, we take a short walking tour where we learn about the lifestyle of the local people and how they grow their vegetables.

In class we acquire the knowledge and secrets of **Khmer cuisine** by using traditional equipment and techniques before we sit down and enjoy the fruit of our labour - lunch.

This afternoon, we embark on a bumpy but fun once in a life time experience on the **Battambang Bamboo Train**, travelling to a nearby village a few km away. Afer an exciting ride, we return to the city and enjoy an entertaining production of human circus and dance at **Phare Battambang**.

After dinner at a local popular restaurant, perhaps we explore the **Night Market**.

## DAY 5 (13 Jan Fri): Battambang/Siem Reap

Breakfast at hotel. Check out and board our VIP coach back to Siem Reap with a coffee/toilet stop and lunch enroute. Reaching Siem Reap, we check into our hotel to freshen up and rest.

This afternoon, we head out to the world's largest freshwater lake in SE Asia, **Tonle Sap Lake**. Enroute we stop over at a Lotus Garden before we board a longtail boat ride through a **floating village of Chhong Khneas**. Then docking with the **Queen Tara Riverboat**, enjoy a sunset cruise with 'all-you-can-drink' including but not limited to champagne, cocktails, wines, spirits, juices, water, soft drinks and cold beers and awesome buffet mixture of Khmer/Asian and Western type foods (organic and locally
